#### FRESH STRAWBERRY PIE

You'll love it – can't be beat!

1 baked 9 inch pie shell  
1 qt. fresh strawberries  
1 cup sugar  
3 tablespoons cornstarch  
Whipped cream

Mash 1/3 of the strawberries; add enough water to make 1 1/2 cups. Place in a saucepan and bring to a boil. Add 1 cup sugar mixed with 3 tablespoons cornstarch

Boil 1 minute; cool completely.

Place the rest of the strawberries in the pie shell; pour the cooled filling over them and chill 2 hours in refrigerator. Serve with whipped cream and decorate with whole berries, if desired.

This is wonderful prepared with fresh peaches or raspberries, too.
